Democracy	<p>When students learn about Matisse's work, they examine his career and the changes in his work. They see how Matisse is affected by the First and Second World Wars.</p> <p>Whilst looking at the work of Hundertwasser, his early years and the effects on his family during the Second World War as a Jewish family are considered.</p>
Mutual respect and tolerance of those with different faiths and beliefs	<p>By covering a variety of artists, the students have to consider a number of styles, viewpoints and ideas behind their work.</p> <p>Hundertwasser's ideas are particularly key to understanding and appreciating his work. He looked at respect for the environment, nature and making individual spaces for everybody.</p> <p>Whilst looking at traditional Still Life work there are many links back to the Old Testament. Objects are used to tell a story to the viewer and get the viewer to consider life, death and faith.</p>
